- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there immediate danger or a risk of further injury?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.

- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services – **999**. Likewise if an emergency police response is required.
- The telephone number for NHS Direct is: **0845 46 47** or see www.nhsdirect.nhs.uk
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- Contact the injured person's parent / carer / guardian.
- Complete an Incident / Accident Report Form. Electronic versions of the form are available from the Club Welfare Officer. A number of blank forms are kept in the First Aid kit located in the groundsman's shed. Completed forms must be referred to the Club Welfare Officer.

These guidelines have been reviewed and readopted in accordance with the ECB Safe Hands Policy.
